City Manager Charles Penny announced that the City of Statesboro is taking in applications for its Youth Connect Program. The last day to apply is March 24, 2025.

Mayor McCollar explained that Youth Connect is a program where we take approximately 30 students in the community for a five week period over the summer to work with the City and other partners across the community. It gives the students an opportunity to get on the job training and experience. If you know of any young people, who may be interested the application can be found on the City of Statesboro website.

Mr. Penny shared there will be a meeting with the Quail Run subdivision on March 25, 2025 at 5:30 pm in the Council Chambers regarding the City's sewer extension project.

Mr. Penny stated at the last Council meeting he asked for authorization to be able to refund some money to an elderly woman who was charged an extremely large amount money for her utility bill over a six-month period due to a running toilet. The city received an email from her daughter expressing her appreciation and thanks for the action that you took to allow us to refund her mother those funds.

Mr. Penny also announced that Brad Deal has been appointed as the Director of Public Works and Engineering and will begin sometime the latter part of April.

The last item Mr. Penny addressed was the Automatic Aid Agreement. Since we have been having discussions with Bulloch County the item of automatic aid has been an item we have discussed quite a bit. On December 3rd the Bulloch County Commissioners voted to cancel the Fire District Agreement effective July 1, 2025. The Automatic Aid agreement is a separate agreement that was approved by the City and County in April of 2020. A 90 day notice is required in order to terminate the agreement. We did discuss at the Council Retreat my recommendation that we give notice of our plan to terminate Automatic Aid. If we do not give notice and we don't hit that 90 day window come July 1, 2025 the City will no longer protect the fire district. However, we would then be responsible for responding in the fire district or throughout the county as a part of Automatic Aid. Mr. Penny asked Mayor and Council to consider approving that the City give notice to Bulloch County of the intention to terminate the Automatic Aid Agreement effective July 1, 2025. Taking this action in no way prevents the City of Statesboro from working with Bulloch County if they would like to work with us.

Mayor Pro Tem Shari Barr explained that she echoes what Mr. Penny stated that the City is still open to trying to work something out. At this point the County has said they are taking it over and we're out and that's how it is but I certainly hope we can still work something out. I know it's not fair for the City of Statesboro taxpayers to subsidize fire service out in the county so I understand the need legally for us to take this next step, but I want to be clear I regret it and still hope we can work something out.

TERMINATION OF CORPORATE GUARANTY

This Termination of Corporate Guaranty ("Termination Agreement"), is made and entered into this _____ day of ____ 2025 ("Effective Date"), by and between the City of Statesboro, Georgia (the "City"), whose address is 50 E. Main Street, Statesboro, Georgia 30458, Aspen Aerogels Inc, located at 30 Forbes Road, Bldg. B., Northborough, MA 01532 ("Guarantor"), and acknowledged by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs ("DCA"), whose address is 60 Executive Park South, NE, Atlanta, Georgia 30329, and Bulloch County, Georgia ("County"), whose address is 113 N Main St., Statesboro GA 30458, collectively, referred to as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2023, DCA awarded the City and County \$750,000.00 in Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Employment Incentive Program ("EIP") funds to specifically assist with water and sewer improvements needed to serve the Guarantor's expansion;

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2023, the City, the County, Aspen Aerogels GA, LLC ("Aspen GA"), and DCA executed the CDBG EIP Agreement (the "Agreement"). This Agreement included certain conditions and responsibilities that the City and Aspen GA had to comply and adhere to;

WHEREAS, the Agreement implemented the EIP grant award of \$750,000.00 ("Grant No. 22q-z-016-2-6328") as delineated in the grant award, dated May 1, 2023, between DCA, the City and County jointly;

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2023, the Guarantor executed the Corporate Guaranty (the "Guaranty") in accordance with certain obligations owed by Aspen GA under the Agreement;

WHEREAS, out of the EIP grant award of \$750,000.00, the City has drawn \$741,000.00 of the grant award;

WHEREAS, _____, the City acknowledged that the Guarantor repaid the \$741,000.00 amount back to the City;

WHEREAS, _____, the City repaid the \$741,000.00 back to DCA;

WHEREAS, the Guarantor and the City have agreed that the Guaranty shall be terminated effective as of the Effective Date, which DCA and the County hereby acknowledge; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants contained herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

<u>Section 1. Termination of Guaranty.</u> As of the Effective Date, the Guarantor is released from all obligations, liabilities, and responsibilities under the Guaranty.

Accordingly, the Guaranty shall be deemed terminated.

Section 2. Acknowledgment by DCA and the County. DCA and the County hereby acknowledge and agree to the termination of the Guaranty as provided herein and releases the Guarantor from any further claims, demands, or liabilities under or in connection with the Guaranty.

<u>Section 3. No Admission of Liability.</u> It is understood and agreed that this Termination Agreement does not constitute an admission of liability by the Guarantor or an admission of any wrongdoing by any party or other, but is solely a reflection of the Parties' desire to terminate the Guaranty under mutually agreed terms.

<u>Section 4. Governing Law.</u> This Termination Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the state of Georgia, without regard to its conflicts of law provisions.

<u>Section 5. Entire Agreement.</u> This Termination Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the Guarantor, City, and DCA with respect to the termination of the Guaranty and supersedes all prior discussions, negotiations, and agreements, whether written or oral, relating to such termination.

<u>Section 6. Counterparts.</u> This Termination Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary in no event shall JSO be liable for any lost profits, lost savings, or other special, incidental or consequential damages, or for punitive or exemplary damages, even if JSO has been made aware of the possibility of such damages, or for any claim against any other party, in connection with the delivery, installation, training, testing, use, performance or nonperformance of the Programs, or the act or failure to act of JSO, or arising out of, related to or in connection with this Agreement.

5. TERMINATION

Upon termination of the license herein granted arising from termination of this license for any reason, licensee shall deliver to JSO all magnetic or otherwise materials, together with all portions, reproductions, and modifications thereof, furnished by JSO and pertaining to the Programs and shall also warrant that all copies thereof have been destroyed or returned to JSO. Within ten (10) days of request by JSO, licensee shall certify in writing to JSO that to the best of licensee's knowledge, the original and all copies, in whole or part, or the Programs have been destroyed or returned to JSO. In addition, all documentation, listings, notes or other written material pertaining to the Program shall be returned to JSO or destroyed. 13. DATA FILES



Project:

The West Main Street intersection improvement project #ENG-123c aims to improve safety and traffic control at the intersection of West Main Street, Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, and Johnson Street through geometric improvements, including but not limited to installation of a roundabout. This parcel was identified as a "total take" in the project concept report. Removal of the subject building will greatly increase the sight distance and safety at this intersection until improvements can be constructed.

Recommendation:

The low bidder, Tidwell Traffic Solutions, meets the requirements of the bid package and submitted an acceptable bid bond. Staff recommends awarding this contract to Tidwell Traffic Solutions in the amount of \$74,030.25.

Background:

The work in this contract includes the installation of thermoplastic striping of approximately 4.66 miles of city streets. The thermoplastic striping shall include 5 inch white and yellow solid striping, 5 inch white and yellow skip striping, 8 inch white solid striping, 24 inch white solid striping, type 2 turn Arrows, and yellow hatching.

The low bidder is Tidwell Traffic Solutions with a bid of \$74,030.25, followed by Mid-State Striping, Inc. with a bid of \$74,739.50.
